

INDEX TO *WINGING IT*, VOLUME I (1989) THROUGH VOLUME 17 (2005)

Roughly 1,100 articles, news stories, letters, and other items from *Winging It* are indexed in the sections below. The selection is exactly that, a selection: many items of purely ephemeral value, such as announcements for events now long past, were consigned to oblivion. Inevitably, then, the index reflects the judgment — and therefore the interests and the limitations — of its compilers. But our goal was to include all material of enduring interest (whether to students of birds, birding, or the ABA), and to structure it in the most useful way possible while still keeping the project manageable in scale. Reflecting what we see as the chief priorities among American Birding Association birders, separate indices follow that list birdfinding material, general ABA and birding subjects, and authors.

While single-year indices, or compilations of several such indices, have appeared from time to time in *Winging It* (generally but not always in December issues), several fairly recent volumes have never been indexed, and no attempt has ever been made to apply consistent indexing standards or procedures to the entire run of the newsletter. This primarily volunteer indexing project was originally proposed in late 2004 by Marc Allaire, when he went looking for specific material in *Winging It* and found that no comprehensive index to the newsletter existed. Marc ultimately compiled index material for nearly all of the years covered and proofread the complete index; former *Winging It* editor Matt Pelikan compiled a few of the newsletter's early years and was the principal editor for the project. The development of methods, structure, and selection was very much a collaborative process, and we are grateful to current *Winging It* editor Rick Wright for extending us the loan of a *Winging It* archive set.

We apologize for errors or oversights, many of which we have surely committed. But we hope that overall, despite its limitations, this index proves useful and adds to the enjoyment of our fellow birders and ABA members. *Winging It* is and always has been a unique publication, and we hope that our efforts have made varied the contents of the ABA's newsletter more accessible.

SUBJECT INDEX

In compiling this index, relatively simple methods were used in order to keep the project to a manageable size. For this reason, most articles appear under only one heading, the one we felt best indicated each article's main topic. Users of the subject section will probably find the index most helpful if they take a few moments to familiarize themselves with the subject headings, a list of which (an "index to the index") appears below. Depending on what information you are looking for, relevant articles may not be listed under the first subject you check.

Articles deemed to have birdfinding as their main focus do not appear here and are indexed above. Keep in mind, though, that many birdfinding articles contain other kinds of information, so a look at the birdfinding index may be in order even if you seek ornithological or ecological information. Material pertaining to the American Birding Association is all listed under "ABA" and sorted by subheadings. Note that "Bird Conservation" and, in a smaller way, several other subjects spawned within themselves two sub-indices apiece, one geographical, one organized by bird species and general bird-related issues and topics. (We hope we may be forgiven for balking at compiling an "index to the *subindices*"!) Only very limited cross-referencing was done, but we did our best to anticipate the topics *Winging It* readers would research.
